2. That Maura Wroblewski received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 1 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
3. That no candidate received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 2 and that Connie Spears and Steve Smith received the most and second most votes cast for that office. Therefore, a runoff election between said candidates is hereby ordered to be held on Tuesday, October 6, 2020, pursuant to the requirements of Section 11-46-20 et seq., of the Alabama Code of 1975 as amended.
4. That Teddy Powell received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 3 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
5. That Greg Shaw received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 4 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
6. That Ranae Bartlett received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 5 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
7. That Karen Denzine received a majority of the votes cast for the office of City Council Member District No. 6 and is hereby declared duly elected to that office for the term beginning on the first Monday in November, 2020.
